OMEGA LAMPLIGHTERS MENTORING PROGRAM



MISSION STATEMENT

The Omega Lamplighters Mentoring Program strives to establish a supportive relationship between mentors and mentees, fostering academic success, personal growth, and community involvement. Our objective is to equip young men with the skills, knowledge, and confidence necessary for success in school, work, and life.

The Omega Lamplighters Mentoring Program continues to make a lasting impact on the lives of young men in our community. Focused on mentorship, personal development, and leadership, the program equips participants with the tools they need to overcome challenges and achieve success. Our goal is to guide these young men as they grow into confident, responsible leaders, prepared to give back to their communities.

Over the past year, we have expanded our reach, providing mentorship opportunities to students from a diverse set of schools across Hamilton County. Through bi-monthly sessions and enriching activities, we have fostered a space for learning, growth, and character development.

Mentoring by the Numbers

- **58%** of our participants come from households that benefit from essential support programs such as free or reduced lunch, income assistance, and housing assistance.
- Our mentees represent **8** schools across Hamilton County, including Chattanooga School for the Arts and Sciences (CSAS), Howard High School, Tyner Academy, Chattanooga Center for Creative Arts, Chattanooga Preparatory School, Chattanooga School for Liberal Arts (CSLA), Hunter Middle School, and the STEM School of Chattanooga.
- The average family income of our participants is **\$40,333**, highlighting the need for mentorship to help these young men thrive despite economic challenges.

Through these numbers, we are reminded of the significance of our work and the profound impact we are making in the lives of our young men and their families.
